Subject: Inspections Procedure Changes
Effective January 1, 2019

The following changes in the information required or the work required to be completed at the time of inspections are specified below by the Inspections they will affect:

A. Rough In:

- All permits to be posted on the job site to include all trade permits
- All penetrations in the exterior building envelop must be sealed prior to the rough in inspection
- Duct blaster test results shall be on site (test required by 2015 Virginia Energy Code)

B. Final: (electrical)

- Inspection of live/energized electrical equipment for generator installations, service changes or relocations will require a contractor's representative on site to remove service panel or other equipment covers to allow for inspection. Please contact the office between 9:30 am and 10:00 am on the day the inspection is scheduled to discuss a time frame when the inspection can be performed with the assigned inspector.

As always, your assistance in this matter are greatly appreciated and will assist us in ensuring your project meets the minimum code requirements.
